### Speaker:

**Matthew Brennand Roper**  
Consultant in Restorative Dentistry, Specialist in Prosthodontics

After qualifying from Bristol in 2007 with distinctions and awards in academic and clinical dentistry, Matthew spent time in practice before heading back into the hospital environment.

Rotations in Restorative Dentistry and Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery at the Bristol Dental Hospital followed by the Royal London and St Bartholomew's Hospitals provided a wealth of experience in general and specialist dentistry, cancer therapies, facial deformity and trauma.

Matthew was successful in winning the only Specialist Registrar post in prosthodontics in the UK in 2010, which was subsequently followed by a restorative training post for a further 4 years.

He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow and is a Clinical Senior Lecturer at the University of Glasgow. Matthew was elected to the UK and Ireland Young ITI Committee in 2018 and also sits on the International Young ITI committee.

Matthew is an invited speaker both nationally and internationally with publications in peer reviewed journals. His interests lie in hard and soft tissue regenerative procedures associated with Hypodontia and implant therapies.
